As the truth has slowly emerged the Police and Prosecution authorities have been forced to concede that the Scottish Criminal Records Office 'experts' involved in my daughter's case are either grossly incompetent or have engaged in criminal behaviour.

It has now been internationally proved beyond any doubt that 'identifications' in the McKie and Asbury cases were erroneous.

This in turn has totally vindicated the fourteen experts from your force who were forced to speak out when it became clear that the 'authorities' were quite prepared to see a 'cover up' of the truth.
